STATEMENT ON PROCUREMENT OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL EQUIPMENT AND PHARMACEUTICALS DURING COVID-19 CRISIS

Dear clients,

As the COVID-19 coronavirus crisis worsens, every medical system in the world is experiencing catastrophic shortages of key equipment and pharmaceutical products required for treatment.

China, India and Turkey and others are major manufacturers of the products that are in highest demand, and have begun reopening some of their production facilities. Unfortunately, many of these companies are state-run, and face export restrictions, creating exclusive relationships with specific countries. This means working with private companies is the only option.

Pharmaxis Group has developed partnerships with several private manufacturers, but production facilities are operating at full capacity and demand is greater than supply.

Delays in placing orders with these manufacturers means there is a risk that we will not be able to access these supplies quickly.
